○Access

- (1) By Taxi from JR Yonago Station: Approximately 15 minutes
- (2) By Taxi from Yonago Airport: Approximately 15 minutes
- (3) By Car via Yonago Expressway: About 15 minutes from Yonago I.C. (Go straight on Route 431 toward Sakaiminato.)
- (4) By Bus: From JR Yonago Station, take the Kamifukuhara-Mitsuyanagi Line toward Jutaku Danchi / Tekko Center, and get off at Jieitai Seimon-mae. Then, about a 7-minute walk.

- (1) Each experience session lasts approximately 40 minutes to 1 hour per discipline.
- (2) The experiences will be conducted in the following order: Kendo → Sumo → Kyudo.

4. Participation Fee: 4,000 yen per person (one session per day)

- (1) Please pay the participation fee at the reception desk of Tottori Prefectural Budokan on the day of your visit.
- (2) Payment can be made in cash or via various cashless methods (credit card, contactless IC, or QR code payment).

6. Meeting Time and Place

- (1) Please complete your participation fee payment at the Budokan office by 9:30 a.m., and gather at the 1st floor entrance by 9:40 a.m.
- (2) The experience activities will begin at 10:00 a.m.

7. Eligibility

Elementary school students and above.

8. Attire

- (1) Please wear comfortable clothing suitable for physical activity and that you don't mind getting dirty.
- (2) During the sumo experience, your clothes may get dirty on the ring, so please bring a change of clothes.
- (3) Shower facilities are available in the building, and you are welcome to use them for an additional fee of 50 yen per person per use.

9. Cancellation Policy

(1) Cancellation Deadlines

- ①Up to 7 days before the participation date: No cancellation fee.
- ②6-3 days before the participation date: 50% of the participation fee will be charged as a cancellation fee.
- ③2 days before to the day of participation: 100% of the participation fee will be charged as a cancellation fee.

(2) How to Notify

- ①Please notify cancellations by email.
- ②No-shows without notice will be charged a 100% cancellation fee.

(3) Refund Method

- ①If a cancellation fee applies, the refund will be made via bank transfer to the designated account.
- ②Bank transfer fees are the responsibility of the participant.

(4) In Case of Bad Weather or Disasters

- ①If the event is canceled due to typhoons, earthquakes, or other disasters, no cancellation fee will be charged.
- ②In principle, cancellations due to delays or suspensions of public transportation will incur the standard cancellation fee.

10. Notes / Precautions

- (1) Please refrain from participating if you are feeling unwell.
- (2) Participants are responsible for their own injuries.
- (3) First aid will be provided, but any other injuries will be handled through insurance.
